

Quilt Show – Information for Members

The Quilt show is **Saturday Feb 23rd** and **Sunday Feb 24th** from 9am-4pm at Palm Ridge Recreation Center.

For Volunteers:

1. If you have volunteered 4 or more hours over the course of the quilt show you are entitled to:
 - Pay \$5 for the 1st day and get in “free” the 2nd day
This Entry Ticket is available from Debbie Dorn.
 - An invitation to the Preview Party
2. Put your Entry Ticket in your name badge holder.
3. You will check in at Summit A Kitchen in Palm Ridge.
 - If you are “first shift begins at 8:45am, please come at 8:30am.
 - All other shifts, please arrive 15 min before your start time.
4. White Gloves and Greeters – Please wear black pants/ Capris and white tops. The gloves and sash will be provided.
5. If you are ill and cannot fill your volunteer time, please call Bonnie Cash 623-512-0762 or Shari Jones 206-380-3503.

Preview Party Friday Feb 22nd from 6pm- 8pm:

1. If you or your friend/spouse volunteered 4 or more hours you and they are invited to the Pre-View Party.
2. You must RSVP to Stephanie Quick in person, call 712-732-5276, or email stphngck@gmail.com.
3. Party is limited to 200.
4. RSVP's will be taken until **Feb 12th** or when we reach **200**.

For Members with Quilt Show Entries:

1. You are expected to work 4 hours at the Quilt Show or on a committee.

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2. All Quilts, except Miniatures, Small Quilts (perimeter is less than 96 inches) and Specialty (Table Runners, Placemats, and Home Dec), need a 4” sleeve. You will be asked to correct any issue such as: no sleeve, no pillow case, prior drop off. If you aren’t sure or want an exception, contact Shari Jones by **Tuesday Feb 21st**.
3. The paper label needs to be basted on the lower left hand corner of the back of the quilt.
4. It is recommended that you have a personal label as well.
5. Remove all loose threads and pet hair.
6. Each Quilt needs to be in it’s own pillowcase. The Entry number, your name, and phone, should be on the case. If you have a large quilt you can make a large pillow case, by taking the seams out and sewing two cases together.
7. Bring your receipt when dropping off the quilt(s). **All Quilts will be brought, Wednesday Feb 20th, outside Summit B at Palm Ridge from 8-12 noon.**
8. You will use this receipt to collect your quilt **Sunday Feb 24th, at 5:30pm.**
9. “What’s on Your Menu” and “Art” Quilts will be picked up in the Acacia Room, everything else will be picked up in Summit A.
10. If someone other than you are picking up your quilt, they **MUST** have this receipt.

For Members Selling Items in the Boutique:

1. Guidelines, Entry forms, price tags, and safety pins are available from Karen Justus.
2. Forms need to be returned by **Tuesday, Feb 19th**.
3. There is no limit to the number of items. They must be finished items, of any season.

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4. All items must have price tags. Follow the directions given to you with the Entry Form.
5. To donate the proceeds of your sale to the club note it on the Entry Form and individual sales tags. You will put QFC -Quilt for Causes, EXP – Expansion on the front of the tag along with your initials and the entry number.
6. Drop off items **Friday, Feb 22** from 9-10am.
7. Pickup Unsold items, **Sunday Feb, 24th** 5pm.
8. The boutique is located in Summit B, you will enter via the patio door.
9. Make sure all items are clean of pet hair and loose threads.
10. Remember the Club will subtract from the sales price - the Village Store fee 16%, Sales Tax 6.3%, and PVP 5%.
11. If you have a quilt in the show that is For Sale, you need to complete a boutique form. The quilt will not be taken down until after the show on Sunday.

Sunday February 24th – Show closes at 4pm

We ask your help by leaving Summit A until 5:30 when quilts are ready for pickup. Unless you are scheduled to work on the hanging, racking, or entry committees. If you want to help with this, please sign up in advance.
